

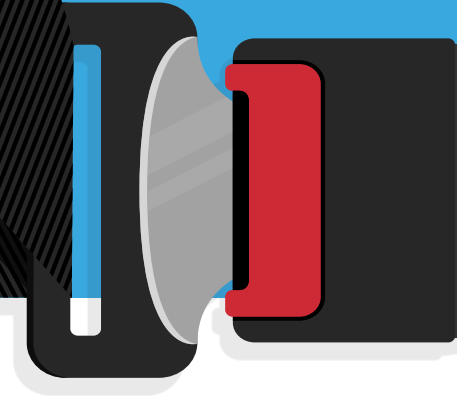
When it clicks, it clicks.

It's the law. Adults who don't buckle up—even in the back seat—face fines and court costs of up to \$200. Kids younger than 8 years must be in a child car seat or booster seat unless they're taller than 4'9"—fines for drivers can reach \$250.

Your seat belt is the most effective safety device in your vehicle. If you're traveling at 50 mph and stop suddenly, your unbuckled body will keep moving at 50 mph. Your seat belt is designed to keep you from being thrown into the dashboard or windshield—or even onto the road.

Airbags need seat belts to work safely. Buckle up to stay securely in your seat, minimizing your risk of injury or death from the airbag's impact.
